RULES & REGULATIONS

- Competition is governed by the rules and regulations of RSOBHD.
- All competitors are expected to comply with the Code of Ethics as printed by SDUSA
- No one other than the competition committee shall communicate with the judge.
- Age will be computed the day of the competition.
- Entries will be divided into categories after closing date. If less than four dancers show up to compete on the day of the competition, classes may be combined.
- Pre-Premier changes please notify Susie Eskridge at least one week prior to the competition. NO CHANGES are allowed on competition day.
- All dancers must present a valid 2023 RSOBHD Registration card when registering. If a dancer does not bring their RSOBHD card with them, they will not be allowed to compete.
- Competitors dance in reverse order of entry. Any dancer not on hand when his/her event is called will forfeit his/her entry in that event.
- A trophy will be awarded to the dancer with the highest points in each class, with the exception of Primary.
- Medals will be given in all classes except for Premier16 & Over. Cash awards for 16 & Over will be \$50, \$40, \$30 and \$20.
 Amounts of cash awards may change depending on class size. Medals will be given if more than four places are awarded.
- It is the dancer's responsibility to abide by the Three-Month Rule (may not have taken any classes, Skype lessons, workshops, etc. with the judges for the event).
- <u>Protests must be made in writing, signed, and given to the competition committee before the end of the competition with a \$10.00 fee.</u>
 The fee is refundable if protest is sustained.

Attention Dancers, Parents and Teachers:

The Seaside Highland Games along with ScotDance USA West would like to make the following reminders for the protection of all dancers.

- We ask all dancers to use the assigned changing areas for costume changes.
- Please do not change costumes in a public area. We will allow enough time between dances for costume changes.
- Also, a reminder for parents, only females are allowed in the Girls changing area and only males are allowed in the Boys changing area
- If you are taking pictures or videos of your dancer, please be sure that you are only photographing or videoing your dancer and not anyone else!
